

Grace Bible School — 2018 Memory Work Program

Each year we ask the Grace Bible School children to memorize age-appropriate “building blocks” of our Lutheran faith. Memory work is an important aspect of Christian education because it fosters understanding of our beliefs while committing the words to the children’s heart and head.

Our 2018 memory work program officially begins Sun., Jan. 7 and Wed., Jan 10, and is designed to be a cooperative effort between church and home. While teachers work with the children in their class, we ask that you, as your child’s primary faith nurturer, also take time to work with your child at home. (Please note that the Bible verses are from the NRSV translation.)

On Sun., Feb. 18, and Wed., Feb. 21, we will celebrate our memory work completion during Grace Bible School. Each age group will recite their verse for the other classes. (Children will not be required to recite individually.)

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself.


